Week Long Trip

This year's week long club trip will be June 12th-19th to Buena Vista, CO. with the first planned day of 4-wheeling starting Sat. June 12th departing from the City Market parking lot at 438 US-24 at 10AM.

We will travel on to the Fourmile area for an easier trail 24.7 miles long and taking 3-4 hours which we will certainly stop for lunch. Then continuing on to Mt. Princeton for a moderate trail 5.4 miles long estimated at around 2 hours to complete. It's been suggested that we try for a group dinner following the day to catch up and discuss upcoming trails to conquer.

Pay two will begin from the same City Market parking lot at our usual departure time of 9AM heading straight for the Moderate to Pifficult Tin cup / Mirror lake trail which is 13 miles long and depending on snow, may become impassable towards the end (Hopefully locals will know before we begin the trail). Tin cup is usually about 2hrs long, and with some luck, we will continue on to Napoleon Pass (6.3 miles and 2-3 hrs), and then finishing on Hancock Pass (17 miles and 3-4hrs) if possible.

After Pay 2, it's up to everyone to decide what trails to run as there are many more at varying degrees of difficulty.

There are Campsites on BLM land available at no cost, as well as lots of RV campsites and loft/rustic cabins at Arrowhead Point Campgrounds & Cabins (where some of us have already reserved sites). https://arrowheadpointresort.com/

Some of us are arriving in Buena Vista that Friday evening June 1 1th, others can choose to meet at the City Market on Saturday June 12th (hence the 10am start time to allow for the 3hr drive from the Ft. Collins area).

There is also rumors of a mid August trip to the Black Hills in South Pakota this year...availability of campsites and hotels doesn't open up until after the Sturgis Motorcycle rally. Stay tuned for more on the SP trip in weeks to come.

I hope you'll join us in Buena Vista this year, there are lots of additional things to do in the area if you need a break from bouncing around in your rig.
