



## Trip Information

- The roads/trails our club run generally involve a variety of challenging obstacles including rocks, snow, ice, and mud. If you get into a situation, you don't feel comfortable with, stop and ask for help. That's why we run as a group and never leave anyone behind.
- If you need fuel or food, go get it now. We will wait for you if you notify the group leader. There are no gas stations or stores on the road/trail.
- You must always stay on the designated road/trail. The Mountaineers are supporters of the "Tread Lightly" and "Stay The Trail" programs.
- If you have a GMRS radio, the club channel is 19. If you have a ham radio, the club will be on the 2-meter band, and the frequency we use is 147.450. The group leader and tail gunner will both have GMRS radios. If you have any questions, vehicle problems, or special requests, please let us know.
- Keep the vehicle in front of you in sight. If you come to a fork in the road, make sure the person behind you sees the way you turn. Occasionally the trip leader will stop to bunch the group together again.
- If we stop for a potty break in the forest, the general rule is ladies to the right and gentlemen to the left.
- The trip leader and the Larimer County 4 Wheel Drive Club are in no way responsible for any damage to your vehicle that may occur on the club trip.
- Be respectful of all other user groups; hikers, bikers, motorcycles, ATVs, side by sides, etc. Any behavior that is deemed to be inappropriate by the Trip Planners will be justification for you to be asked to leave.
- No alcohol or drugs are to be consumed during the trip/event. No exceptions, if you are suspected of alcohol or drug use you will be asked to leave.
- Please read the waiver on the reverse side and complete the Guest Log.

IN ADDITION, the undersigned AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS the Mountaineers from any loss, liability damage, or cost he/she incurs due to such participation by the undersigned, whether caused by the Mountaineers decisions or otherwise and AGREES TO ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY AND RISK for any bodily injury, death, or property damage from the Mountaineers decisions or otherwise while the undersigned is participating in this event. By executing this instrument, you further authorize the Mountaineers to use your name, photos of you and/or your vehicle for publicity, advertisement, endorsements, magazine articles or as deemed appropriate for off road motor sports. In signing this release, the undersigned hereby acknowledges and represents the following: 1) He/she has read the foregoing Release and Waiver of Liability. 2) While riding in a vehicle participating in this event, all participants must always wear his/her applicable safety equipment. 3) His/her vehicle is in good mechanical condition. 4) He/she has informed himself/herself about the event and road/trail involved, either by prior participation or investigation into the event and road/trail. 5) He/she takes all responsibility for vehicle passengers and other drivers. 6) The undersigned acknowledges he/she is aware the Mountaineers assumes no duty to supervise the activities of any participant, spectator, or other individuals. The Mountaineers assumes no liability for the acts or omissions of any such individuals. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS! NO EXCEPTIONS! You will be asked to leave the premises if you are suspected of using alcohol or drugs during the trip/event. If you behave in any manner that might put others in danger, you will be asked to leave the trip/event. PLEASE BE SAFE AND RESPECT OTHERS AND THE LANDOWNERS OF THE PROPERTY YOU ARE ON.
